



Northwest History Network Summer Excursion to Hood River - Saturday, August 15th!

Please join us on Saturday, August 15th, from 11:00 am to 4:30 pm for an NHN excursion to explore the historic town of Hood River, Oregon!

All Northwest History Network Associates and their families and friends are invited to join the excursion, which will be hosted by Matt Carmichael, NHN Associate, Archivist and Historian of the Episcopal Diocese of Eastern Oregon, and Archivist at the History Museum of Hood River County.

We will begin by meeting Matt at St. Mark's Church in Hood River at 11:00 am, and he has kindly offered to shuttle 6 or 7 attendees around to the sites in the church's van.

From the church we will begin the tour by visiting the History Museum of Hood River County - <http://www.co.hood-river.or.us/museum>. After visiting the museum there will be a walking tour of Hood River conducted by Matt Carmichael.

Then it will be time for a late lunch at the Three Rivers Grill - <http://www.threeriversgrill.com/>. After lunch we will visit the Western Antique Aeroplane and Automobile Museum (WAAAM) - <http://www.waaamuseum.org/>. The excursion will then conclude back at St. Mark's Church.

Admission to the two museums will be covered for those who attend the excursion. Lunch will not be covered.

The address of St. Mark Church is 400 11th Street, Hood River, OR 97031, and here are directions from Portland:

Take I-84 East from Portland to Hood River (61 miles). Take the West Hood River Exit 62, and turn Right at the stop sign onto Cascade Ave. Follow Cascade Ave until the stop light, and turn Right onto 13th St. Take the first left onto State Street, continue down State Street until you reach 9th Street. Turn Right on 9th Street. Go up the hill and turn Right onto Eugene St. Follow down Eugene Street and turn Right onto 11th Street. Turn left into the parking lot of St. Mark's Church.
